Council sets sights on exciting new indoor stadium site

At last night's Council Meeting, Councillors announced Percy Treyvaud Memorial Park as the preferred site for the proposed indoor stadium and for a detailed feasibility study to be undertaken.

It's a massive boost for the community as it will provide a highly relevant, new and contemporary facility to cater for current and future demands – thousands of Stonnington residents will benefit from the new infrastructure.

The feasibility study will focus on the overall plan and opportunities for the project at the Council-owned site which is currently occupied by the Chadstone Bowls Club.

City of Stonnington Mayor Cr Jami Klisaris said, "There is a strong need for an indoor stadium in Stonnington to cater for the increasing demand in stadium sports, particularly netball and basketball.

"As part of the feasibility study, Council will be working closely with the Chadstone Bowls Club and its members to develop a forward plan for their future requirements," added Cr Klisaris.

It is proposed that the stadium include four courts with car parking, seating, and changeroom facilities, drastically improving the opportunity for local sports enthusiasts to participate in indoor sports.

The Percy Treyvaud Memorial Park site is ideally placed to cater for the indoor stadium with excellent transport links and sufficient space for four indoor courts and associated carparking.
