What is the completion date for the @Leisure contract for the Chadstone Bowls Club consultation?


Response

@Leisure Planners has been appointed to directly engage with the Chadstone Bowls Club, Chadstone Tennis Club and Chadstone Recreation and Civic Club so that Council is made fully aware of the potential impact the proposed indoor stadium would have on each club and their members.

@Leisure will produce an independent report that assesses the viability of the existing bowls club and the potential to accommodate the club or its members elsewhere and make recommendations to Council.

The cooperation of the Chadstone Recreation and Civic Club in this process is strongly encouraged so that it can be completed in a timely manner and inform subsequent stages of the feasibility study.
